(All references to this legislation in this Notice of extension of approved use and in any annexes to it are to the same as amended to the date of issue of this notice).

This extension of the approved use provides for the use of the product named below in respect of crops and situations, other than those included on the product label. Such an 'an extension of use', is at all times done at the user's choosing, and the commercial risk is entirely theirs.

The conditions below are obligatory. They must be complied with when the extension of use occurs. Failure to abide by the conditions of approval may constitute a breach of that approval, and a contravention of the Plant Protection Products Regulations 2005. For the purposes of this extension of use only, the conditions and/or requirements shown below supersede any corresponding conditions and/or requirements set out on the label or otherwise provided for under the main approval which would otherwise apply.


Operator Protection:

- (1) Engineering control of operator exposure must be used where reasonably practicable in addition to the following personal protective equipment:
 - (a) Operators must wear suitable protective clothing (coveralls) and suitable protective gloves when handling the concentrate and when handling contaminated surfaces.
 - (b) Operators must wear suitable protective clothing (coveralls), suitable protective gloves and rubber boots when applying by hand-held equipment.
 - (c) Operators must wear suitable protective clothing (coveralls) when applying by vehicle-mounted equipment.
- (2) However, engineering controls may replace personal protective equipment if a COSHH assessment shows that they provide an equal or higher standard of protection.

Other specific restrictions:

- (1) This product must only be applied in accordance with the terms of this authorisation, the product label and/or leaflet and any additional guidance on extensions of authorisation
- (2) Since this product is harmful to livestock, all livestock must be kept out of treated areas for at least 24 hours after treatment.
- (3) Straw or haulm from treated crops must not be used as animal feed (or bedding) for at least 4 days after last application.
- (4) If 'Agral' is included, the maximum concentration must not exceed 100 ml 'Agral' per 100 litres diluted spray.

- (5) This product must not be applied through ultra low volume equipment (ULVA) or mistblower equipment.
